This means that we must have sincere trust in our fellow pilgrims, putting aside all suspicion or mistrust, and turn our gaze to what we are all seeking: the radiant peace of God's face. Trusting others is an art and peace is an art. Jesus told us: 'Blessed are the peacemakers' (Mt 5:9). In taking up this task, also among ourselves, we fulfil the ancient prophecy: 'They shall beat their swords into ploughshares' (Is 2:4)" (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 244).
