

Mass Etiquette

Cross yourself with Holy Water on entering & leaving the church. This is a reminder of our Baptism which made us members of Christ's Church.

Genuflect towards the Tabernacle when entering or leaving church. If you are physically unable to genuflect then a bow is sufficient. If you pass in front of the altar or tabernacle during Mass then you should now reverently.

Dress modestly and appropriately.

Show up at least a few minutes early. If for any reason you're late then try to sit at the back so you don't disturb others.

Mobiles phones should never be used during Mass. The only exceptions are emergencies! If it is necessary to use one please walk out of church to do so. Please try to be discreet if using the phone for readings or prayers.
